Critical and Analytic Thinking (CT)

- Identify beliefs vs. assumptions vs. facts in arguments
- Identify the relationships among statements or ideas in an argument
- Identify the structure of arguments (e.g., premises, conclusions)
- Examine or weigh the relevance and accuracy of evidence presented in an argument
- Evaluate the logic or validity of conclusions drawn in an argument
- Formulate valid arguments
- Support an argument with evidence
